**Fifth Sunday in Lent: March 21, 2021:** *Jeremiah 31:31 -34; Psalm 51:1-12 or Psalm 119:9-16; Hebrews 5:5-10; John 12:20-33* 

"The days are surely coming, says the LORD, when I will make a new covenant with the house of Israel and the house of Judah...I will put my law within them, and I will write it on their hearts;" Jeremiah 31:31 and 33.
