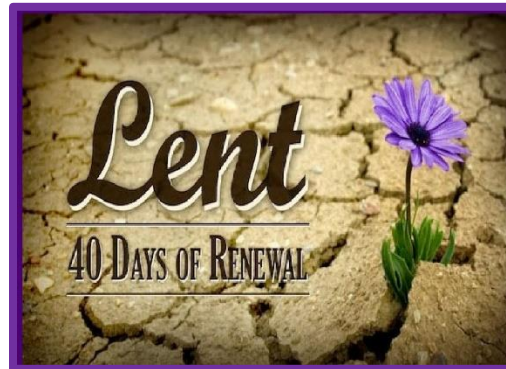

Sunday in Lent,
March 19, 2023: 1**
Samuel 16:1-13;
Psalm 23; Ephesians
5:8-14; John 9:1-41

"As he walked along, he saw a man blind from birth. His disciples asked him, "Rabbi, who sinned, this man or his parents, that he was born blind?" Jesus answered, "Neither this man nor his parents sinned; he was born blind so that God's works might be revealed in him...I am the light of the world." John 9:1-3 and 5

I love the way Jesus addresses this distorted view of sin and suffering. He replaces the standard mindset of fault finding and guilt-stirring with an invitation to believe that pain and sorrow are occasions to experience how "God's works might be revealed in US!"

Times when we are discouraged or misunderstood or taken advantage of, are moments to learn how God loves and appreciates us. The mundane and the magnificent become incredible opportunities to experience God's transforming grace.

A simple prayer might be Oh God make me aware of your presence with me, around me and to see you in me, no matter what. Amen
